
infoDev Lessons learned in Eastern Europe and Central Asia

- •Access to Finance support activities in Kazakhstan, Moldova, Belarus (2012/2013) and lessons learned in Russia and Ukraine
- •Potentials: Private investment and growing middle class / Innovation areas in ICT, agriculture... / Public funding for innovation and entrepreneurship
- •Challenges: Entrepreneurship culture / Public-private sector links and Trust issue / Legal system and incentives / Role of public sector
- •Recommendations: Awareness raising on three levels (startup, investors, public sector) / Legal system / Co-investment funds feasible?



infoDev Lessons learned around the globe

- Money drain and Diaspora potentials
- Ecosystems: In emerging and developing countries, investments into all components of startup ecosystems are required
- Sector focus examples: Angel and investment funds linked to sector-focused incubators/accelerators (infoDev examples: Agribusiness Innovation Centres, Climate Innovation Centres, mLabs)
- Champions kicking off the wave

- Awareness raising on three levels, and trust-building
